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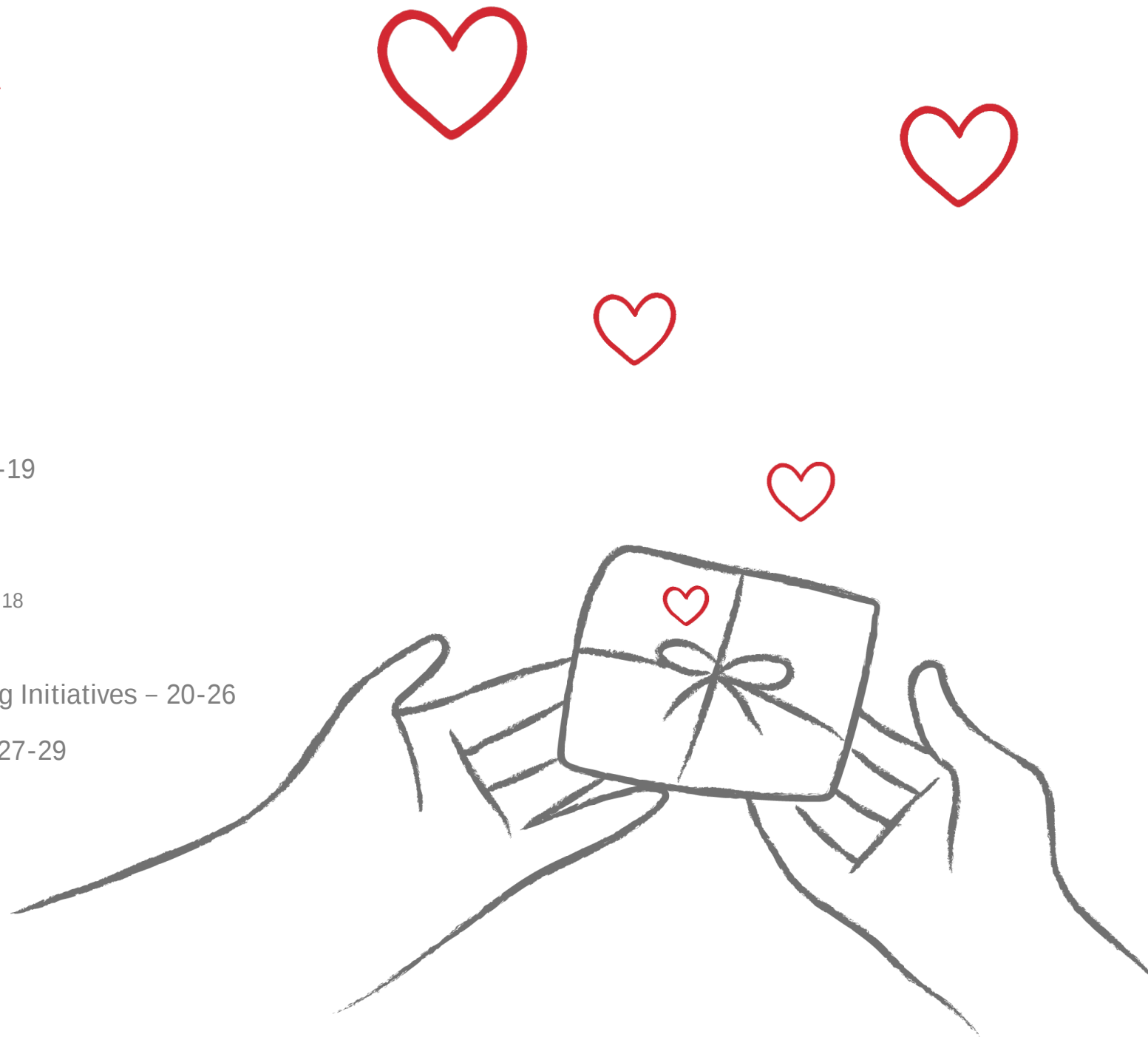
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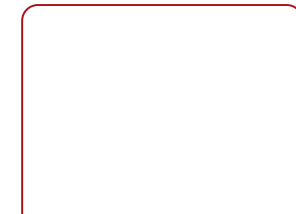
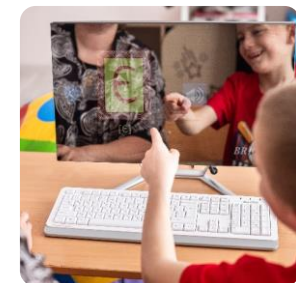
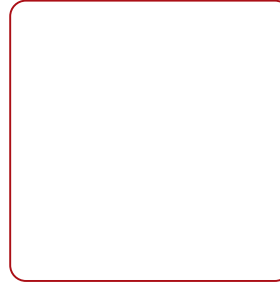
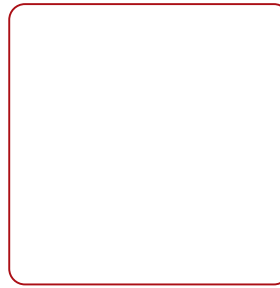
Our Story

The story of Ukraine Charity began in 2007, when a group of Ukrainian professionals based in London visited an orphanage in Lviv shortly before Christmas. During their visit, they witnessed children living without adequate supplies and lacking a safe, warm environment. The experience left a profound impression on them.

Upon returning to London, they shared their experience with friends and colleagues. What began as a modest effort to collect donations quickly grew into a broader initiative, generating enough support to fund essential repairs and improvements for the orphanage. The positive impact on both the children and staff demonstrated the powerful results that can be achieved when people unite with a shared sense of compassion and responsibility.

Motivated by this success, the group established Ukraine Charity to bring together the efforts of like-minded individuals. The organisation was created to facilitate the exchange of ideas, coordinate fundraising activities, and deliver projects effectively—particularly those supporting vulnerable children.

Since its foundation, the charity has remained largely volunteer-led. Its work is sustained through the dedication of volunteers, the generosity of donors and supporters, and a shared commitment to ensuring that the maximum possible support reaches those who need it most.





Foreword

Since February 2022, Ukraine and its people have faced immense challenges. As Ukrainians and the team behind Ukraine Charity, we feel this deeply. Yet throughout this time, we have also witnessed extraordinary compassion and generosity from those who chose to help.

Our mission remains focused on supporting underprivileged children. At the same time, the realities of war have required us to respond to urgent needs — providing crisis medical relief, supporting rescuers, and helping the most vulnerable communities.

Thanks to your support, since 2022 we have raised more than £3 million, funded over 300 projects, and reached more than 50,000 children across Ukraine. From helping families near the frontline to funding ambulances, life-saving equipment and community initiatives, every contribution has made a real difference.

Ukraine Charity is run by a small team of professional volunteers, with most donations coming from like-minded supporters across the UK. Without a physical office, we keep administrative costs below 3%, ensuring that the vast majority of funds go directly to those who need them most.

Alongside humanitarian work, we also organise fundraising initiatives and support cultural and awareness projects that strengthen the Ukrainian voice in the UK.

Thank you for standing with us. Your generosity continues to bring hope and practical support to thousands of children and families across Ukraine.

PROJECTS WE SUPPORTED





CHILDREN – Safety and Protection

Since many years, we have supported **Misto Dobra**, Ukraine's largest shelter for women and children in crisis. It offers safety, warmth, and a fresh start for survivors of violence, occupation, and homelessness.

Its **House of Butterflies** medical centre provides 24/7 care and rehabilitation for critically ill children.

Today, more than 300 residents—and even rescued animals—find protection and hope here during the war.





CHILDREN – Support for Children with Special Needs

Trypillya Training & Rehabilitation Centre

Thanks to your support, we funded an interactive speech-therapy mirror that is helping 76 children improve communication, confidence, and learning through play-based, developmental activities.

Fastiv Training & Rehabilitation Centre

An interactive educational table is now enriching the learning experience of 151 children, helping them communicate, participate, and discover new skills in an accessible and engaging way.

Mostyshche Special School

A new indoor play labyrinth now supports 44 children with disabilities, giving them a safe and joyful space to develop motor skills, coordination, and courage while experiencing the simple joy of childhood.





CHILDREN – Healing and Resilience

In partnership with **Care in Action**, we supported therapeutic camps, creative programmes, and respite days for foster parents—bringing healing, connection, and confidence to war-affected families across the Lviv region.





CHILDREN – Mental support for War-Affected Women and Children

Through partnerships with **Women and War Ukraine Charity** supported programs offering vital psychological care for women and children affected by trauma.

Through individual sessions, group meetings, and online support, these initiatives help families process fear, grief, and displacement — and begin to heal.

CHILDREN – Medical & Social Support

Detdom.info has been our valued partner for more than a decade. In the context of the ongoing war and its impact on children, we recognise an increased responsibility to support their work. Their long-standing initiative, “**Successful Star**”, helps orphaned graduates transition into independent adulthood by building essential life skills and confidence. Alongside soft skills development, the program also provides practical in-kind and financial support, enabling young people to meet immediate needs and establish a stable foundation after leaving institutional care. Over the past three years, we have proudly supported this program, helping participants become more self-reliant and better prepared for adult life.



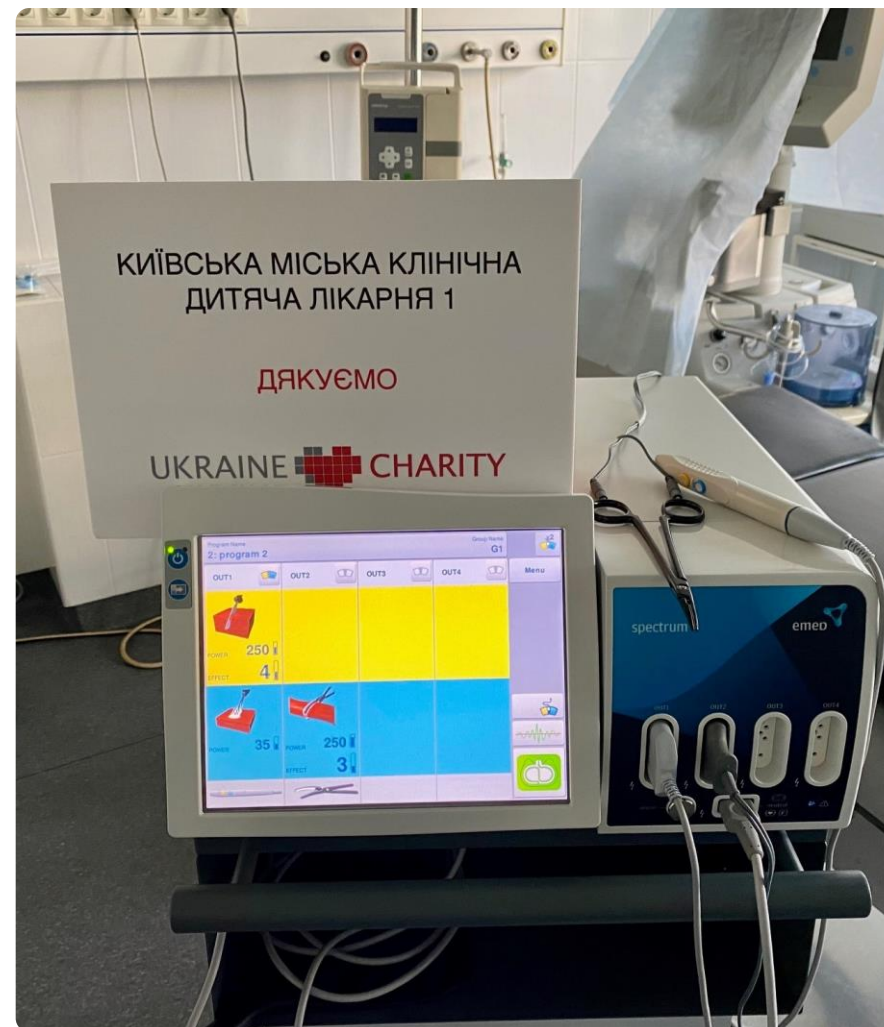


CHILDREN – Medical & Social Support

This year, we deepened our cooperation with trusted partners who deliver life-changing care:

Zaporuka: Funding critical hospital equipment for children.

Ukraine Charity sponsored the purchase of a new **SPECTRUM electrosurgical device** for small patients of the Kyiv City Children Clinical Hospital No. 1. Hospital surgeons are already actively using it daily.



Universal Aid Ukraine: Purchase of 300 CAT Tourniquets

Canvas for Care combines art and humanitarian support for Ukraine. Artist Max Denison-Pender created a series of paintings and donated the proceeds to fund life-saving tourniquets for medics in Ukraine. Universal Aid Ukraine assists with distributing of this medical aid.

Projects we Supported

VULNERABLE PEOPLE – Warmth, Light, and Safety for Communities in Need

Together with Kozak Mamai, we supported hundreds of families living in de-occupied and frontline regions.

Through the “Light, Warmth, Communication” project, we delivered **15 UPS power units, 1,000 warmers, 50 folding beds, and 500 SICH tourniquets**, helping families stay safe during outages and constant shelling.

We also supported the Invasport para swimming and triathlon school, giving children and young athletes access to rehabilitation, training, and community.





VULNERABLE PEOPLE – Support for Displaced Families

In partnership with the **Social City Charitable Foundation**, we helped deliver food packages to evacuees from the Kupiansk district now living in a dormitory in Kharkiv. Many are elderly and unable to support themselves. We are deeply grateful to our partners for ensuring that these families receive care, dignity, and consistent support. Together, we continue to extend a helping hand where it is needed most.





VULNERABLE PEOPLE – Rehabilitation for the Injured

In Kharkiv, where daily attacks continue to threaten civilian life, **Ukraine Charity** helped provide essential rehabilitation for those injured in the war.

We also supported Ukrainian amputees who bravely completed the **London Marathon**, turning their personal journey into a message of resilience and hope.





EMERGENCY RESPONSE – Delivering Lifelines Across Ukraine

Ukraine Charity funded the delivery of over 20 vehicles kindly donated by 'Biedriba TEV' from Latvia and coordinated by All-Ukrainian League of Ukrainian Women (ALUW).

These vehicles now serve orphanages, hospitals, frontline communities, and remote villages, ensuring that essential support reaches those who need it most.





EMERGENCY RESPONSE – Hospitallers-Medical Battalion

Ukraine Charity remains a steadfast supporter of the **Hospitallers**, a volunteer paramedic force saving lives on the front line.

This year, we contributed a fully equipped **ambulance**, **medical supplies**, **first aid kits**, **Celox**, **portable oxygen concentrators**, and **blood plasma components** — ensuring that medics can reach the wounded and bring them to safety.





EMERGENCY RESPONSE – the Ukrainian Firefighters Foundation

Since 2023, Ukraine Charity has been providing support to Ukrainian rescuers through our trusted partner, **the Ukrainian Firefighters Foundation**. Through this partnership, we sponsor the purchase of highly specialised rescue vehicles and equipment, contributing more than **£70,000** to strengthen the operational capacity of Ukrainian emergency responders.





EMERGENCY RESPONSE – Help 4 Ukraine

Back in December 2024, together with **Help 4 Ukraine**, we launched a major fundraising campaign at our **Black-Tie Dinner & Auction**, raising over **£40,000** thanks to the generosity of our supporters.

In June 2025, eight ambulances arrived in Ukraine, delivered by an incredible team of dedicated volunteers from Help 4 Ukraine.



These are not just vehicles — they are mobile lifelines, already bringing hope and saving lives where it is needed most.



SUPPORT – Women and the World International Film Festival

Ukraine Charity proudly supports the **Women and the World International Film Festival**, founded by a Ukrainian film professional in 2025. Held annually in London, the festival showcases films by female directors from over 40 countries, celebrating the resilience and leadership of women in conflict zones while bringing together voices from cinema, media, and activism worldwide.

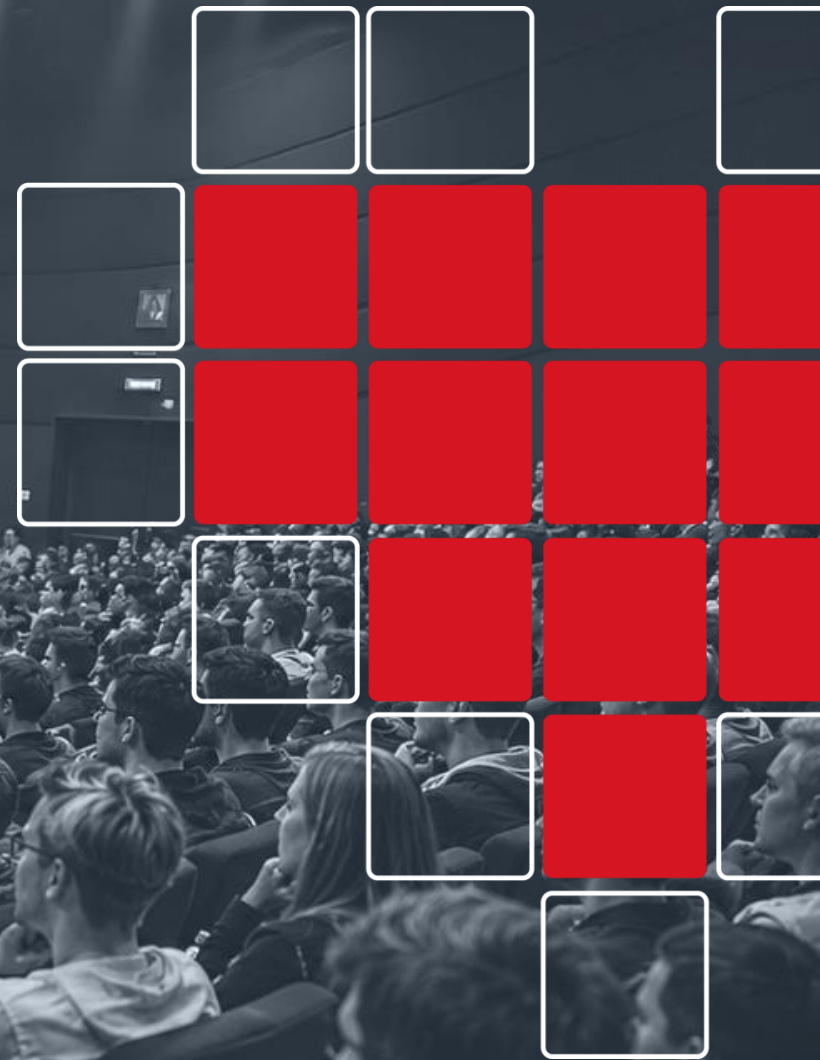

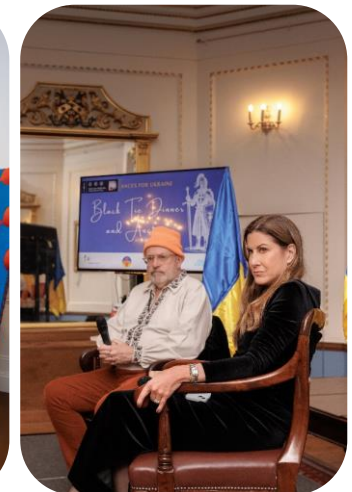
